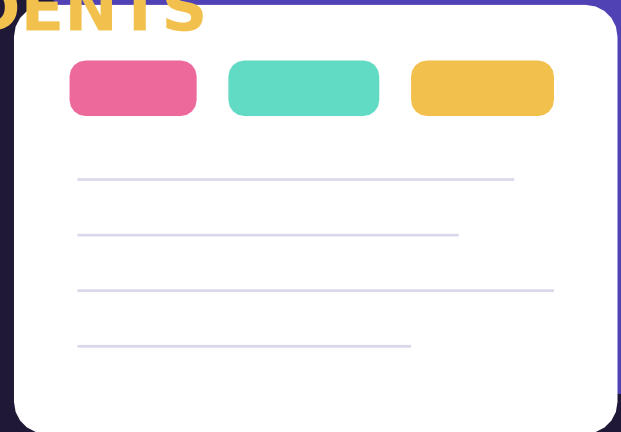

The L.E.A.R.N.

A study prompt is not a magic order – it is an agreement on goal, materials, mental activity, trial, and control.

Letter	Lock	Question
L	Level	What do I already know and what do I need to be able to do?
E	Evidence	What materials and sources can I use?
A	Activities	What cognitive effort do I have to make?
R	Result	What format helps me learn?
N	Non-negotiable	Policy, Privacy, Sources, Integrity, and Verification

CENTRAL RULE

Ask AI to create useful friction: questions, clues, feedback, examples, and tests. If it produces the evaluated work directly, you have skipped the part that was supposed to train you.

Five checks before sending

- ☐ Have I indicated the subject, level and objective?
- ☐ Have I only provided materials that I can use?
- ☐ Have I specified what kind of aid is allowed?
- ☐ Did I ask not to invent sources?
- ☐ Have I planned my own attempt and a final test?

Using Study mode without delegating thought

When Study mode is available, it can guide with questions, progressive explanations, and comprehension checks. Availability and activation path may change; Always consult the official guide. Even in Study mode, answers may contain errors and the course policy remains a priority.

Useful use	Education
Concept	Ask me questions before explaining
Problem	Offer one clue at a time
Reading	Ask me for theses and proofs before feedback
Exam	Show the solution only after the attempt
Writing	Comment on my draft, don't write the final text
CONTROL End each session with: what I can explain without AI, what I need to check and what exercise I will do on my own.	

How to use the 500 prompts

Step	Action
1	Choose the category and prompt closest to your needs
2	Replace all fields in square brackets
3	Glue only authorized and necessary materials
4	Give it a try before asking for more help
5	Verify sources, calculations, citations, and policies
6	Record what you've changed and learned
7	Rerun the task without AI to check mastery
